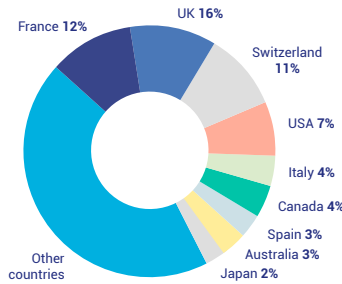

**Competence-based curriculum framework**

In partnership with UNESCO's International Bureau of Education, we have identified seven competences for all Ecolint students to develop and bring to the world for the common good:

**High School Diploma**

The High School Diploma is earned by completing 24 credits with the following minimum credits in each subject: Language and Literature 4, Language Acquisition 3, Mathematics 3, Sciences 3, Individuals and Societies 3, Arts 1.5 and Physical Education 1.5. All student assessment is criteria-based on a scale from 1 to 7. A grade of 3 or more earns a subject credit towards the High School Diploma.

**Campus Curriculum**

Years 10-11

**IB Middle Years Programme**

A broad and balanced curriculum in eight subject groups: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics, Arts, Design, Physical and Health Education. Every year students engage in a collaboratively planned interdisciplinary unit. In Year 11, students complete an independent personal project of approximately twenty-five hours. The project is externally moderated by the IB.

Years 12-13 (option 1)

**IB Diploma Programme**

The broad and balanced IB curriculum is made up of six subject groups, all with external exams: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics and the Arts. Three subjects are studied at higher level and three at standard level over two years and a core that includes Theory of Knowledge, an Extended Essay and extensive engagement with Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS).

Years 12-13 (option 2)

**IB Career-related Programme**

The curriculum is made up of a career-related qualification along with a minimum of two IB Diploma courses, a personal and professional skills course, a service learning portfolio, language development portfolio and an extensive reflective project in their career-related area of study.



**Ecolint Learner Passport**

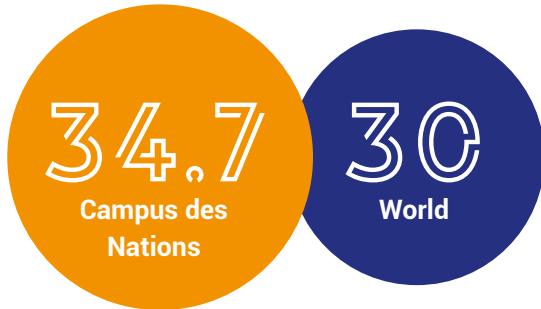

## IB Diploma pass rate – 2022/2023

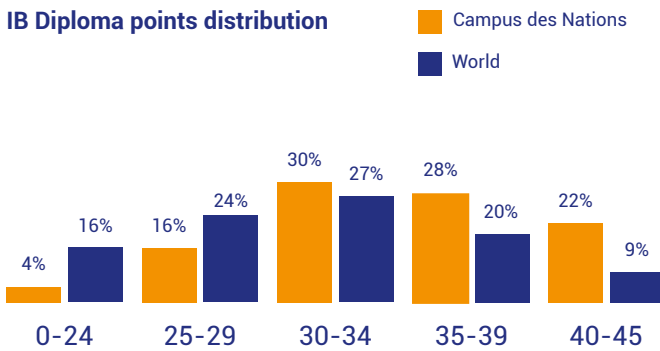

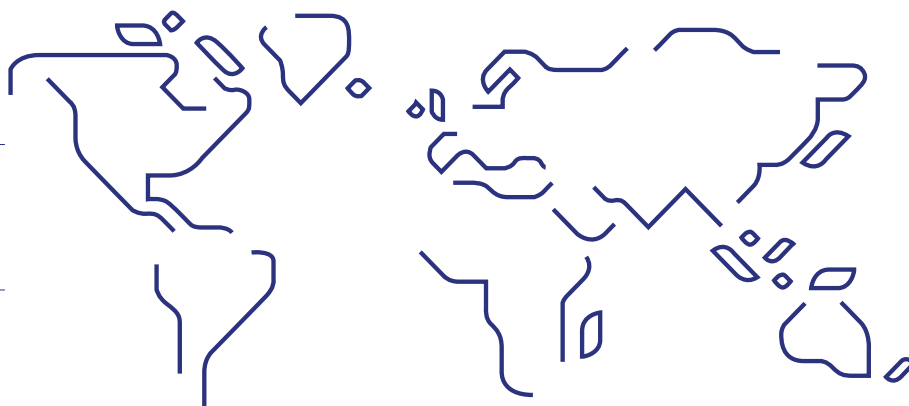
